The essence of north Norfolk living is captured in stylish comfort. This friendly, family run hotel is gloriously situated on the marshland coastline of picturesque Brancaster Staithe, north Norfolk, with hauntingly captivating views across seascape tidal marsh, designated an area of outstanding natural beauty, to Scott Head Island and beyond to the sea. The Norfolk coastal path runs along the bottom of the garden. The coastline is a magical area to explore with panoramic breathtaking views and never ending sandy beaches.

A warm welcome is assured at this award winning establishment set in a spectacular location, tranquil, yet bustling and full of Norfolk life.

There are 15 individually styled, cosy bedrooms to call home for your stay. The 8 garden rooms have their own terrace, well-behaved dogs are welcome in these rooms. 7 more rooms upstairs in the main building including the 'Room at the Top' with viewing terrace and telescope which offers spectacular views across the tidal marsh to the sea beyond.
